### **VINCENZO “JIMMY” DE PINTO FAMILY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Established in 1998, one \$5,000 one-time award is made available annually to a qualifying high school senior in memory of the family of Vincenzo “Jimmy” De Pinto, a late president of the Society, for his contributions to the Società Madonna Dei Martiri, the Hoboken Italian Festival and his devotion to the Madonna.

Emigrating from Italy and becoming a citizen of the United States, Mr. De Pinto never abandoned his Italian culture and traditions, nor ceased his devotion to the Madonna, the patron saint of Molfetta, the city of his birth.

Similar to the multitude of Italian-Americans who left their homeland to start a new life, he strongly believed in his adopted country, and valued the opportunities available for those willing to work for it. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was proud to be one of the tens of thousands of Italian-Americans who helped build the United States. Though higher education was never available to him, he believed that education was essential, in that it secured the future of the individual and of his newly adopted country.

This scholarship celebrates the memory of Vincenzo “Jimmy” De Pinto, a respected man of integrity and ethnic pride, who had a strong belief in Our Lady, the love of family and our country.

This award is also in memory of deceased members of Mr. De Pinto’s family who played an active role in the Society. Anna, Jimmy’s wife, the only female member, was an Honorary President and considered the Matriarch of the Society. Aldo, his oldest son, proudly upheld and continued his father’s traditions by also serving as president of the Society.

*Applicants must satisfy the following requirements:*

- A descendent of a family member from Italy
- A Hoboken, New Jersey or other local area resident
- A graduating senior from Hoboken High School, St. Peter’s Prep, St. Dominic Academy or other area high schools.
- Accepted to a four-year college and attending in September, 2019
- Descendants of Vincenzo “Jimmy” De Pinto are not eligible.
- Members of the Society and their families are not eligible.

*Applications are evaluated by the De Pinto Family, the President of the Society and the President of the Feast Committee (or his appointee) on the basis of:*

- Academics and academic awards
- Athletics, extra-curricular activities and jobs held while in school
- Community service
- A written essay

*The following must accompany completed application forms:*

- High school transcript.
- Letter of acceptance from a four-year college and acknowledgement to attend.
- Two letters of reference, one of which must be from a faculty member of your high school.
- A 500-word essay describing your intended course of study, any Italian-Americans who have made contributions in this field and why you feel deserving of the scholarship.
- Please send application as a complete packet and not separately.
